
Earth Youth Summit 2025 in KYOTO Executive Committee

Our Story

The year 2030 is approaching. It is a milestone for achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Our society seeks talented people who can identify the structure of social problems, engage in dialogue, discuss and examine solutions, and implement them. Our aim is to achieve the SDGs by 2030 and create a sustainable society by 2050. Therefore, we, Kyoto Beyond SDGs Consortium, hold "Earth Youth Summit in KYOTO". This is the successor to "Solve Problems And Revolutionize from Kyoto University" (SPARKU), which ran from 2020. Both events focus on developing junior and senior high school students as future leaders, and the updated one has expanded its scope globally. In 2023, we had Earth Youth Summit 2023 in KYOTO, in the Keihoku area, northern part of Kyoto City. And more, in 2024, we did an online annual programme and an on-site summit in Miyazu City, Kyoto. At that event, students all over the world joined discussions. In 2025, our goal is to implement actions designed by participants. Expo 2025 Osaka-Kansai and Keihanna Expo 2025 will provide an opportunity for this. In the annual programme for junior and senior high school students, discussing in English is recommended. Participants are encouraged to put their ideas into practice rather than simply keeping them in mind. Of course, mentors from various fields will help you. Through this programme, students will improve their communication skills, develop empathy and clarify their aspirations through collaboration with others in the global society. And networking opportunities will also be available. We hope that this programme will provide a great opportunity for future leaders to deepen their thinking on various social issues and improve their ability to communicate effectively.

Outline

It has 2 parts in the Earth Youth Summit 2025. In Part I, "Introductory Lecture" (optional), participants will improve English discussion skills and acquire basic knowledge for Part II. In part II, "Main Seminar", we have discussion and group working.



[Introductory Lecture] *Optional

We have 3 lectures from February to March 2025 on Zoom. These are for getting basic knowledge about SDGs and deepening students' familiarity with English. Online discussion will be held on scheduled date. Students need to watch the lecture videos before the discussion part.

[Main Seminar]

From March to October 2025, we will have group works on Zoom within small groups. Each group should set one theme which is related to sustainability and discuss deeply to create their action. On-site summit "Keihanna Summit" will be held in Keihanna Science City from August 4th to 6th. Each group will bring and present the results of their discussions. And they will aim to deepen their discussions by visiting and learning there. In October, we will have a final presentation to share the achievements in a hybrid format.

Application Requirements

- ①Applicants must be in their 3rd year of junior high school, 1st year of high school, or 2nd year of high school (* 3rd, 4th, or 5th year in the case of secondary schools) at the time of application.
- ②Those who are interested in the leadership for the next generation, and activities related to environmental issues and the SDGs.
- 3)Those who can prepare to participate seminars by using the online meeting application.

First lecture will be on 8th February 2025, but we accept participants after the first lecture starts. If you want, the application form should be submitted up to 3 days before the date.

[Application for Main Seminar]

Deadline of application is March 22nd, 2025. For main seminar, we will carry out a selection. Applicants will get the results at a later date. If we have a lot of aspirants, priority may be given to who have joined the introductory lectures.
